



The Special Diet Home-Delivered Meals Program provides nutritious meals to older adults who are homebound, require a special diet, and are unable to shop for groceries or prepare meals on their own.

Some of the approved diets for this program include:

- Pureed
- Mechanical soft
- Finger foods
- Carbohydrate Controlled Diet (CCD)
- 2 gm sodium and more.

Eligible adults are:

- Aged 60 years and older
- Frail or homebound individuals, including those temporarily incapacitated due to illness or isolation, are unable to shop or prepare meals.
- The spouse of an eligible individual may receive a home-delivered meal if it helps reduce their stress in caring for the client.

- Hot and cold meals available
- Delivery: Monday - Saturday; 10:00am - 3:00pm
- Two routes available:
 - *M, W F and T, Th, Sat*
- Areas served: Lyons, Riverside and Proviso Townships
- Sliding scale donations appreciated; no donation required for eligibility if in need.
- The number of meals per day will depend on need and agency approval.
